ODD is a small family-run business specialising in outdoor furniture and fabrics.

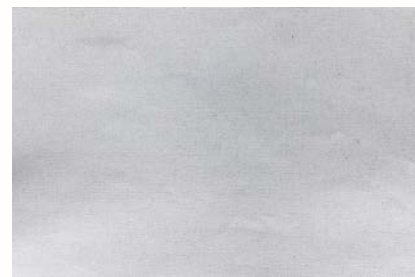

They are specifically designed for the outdoors - waterproof, rot-resistant - and with a little care will be handed down through generations



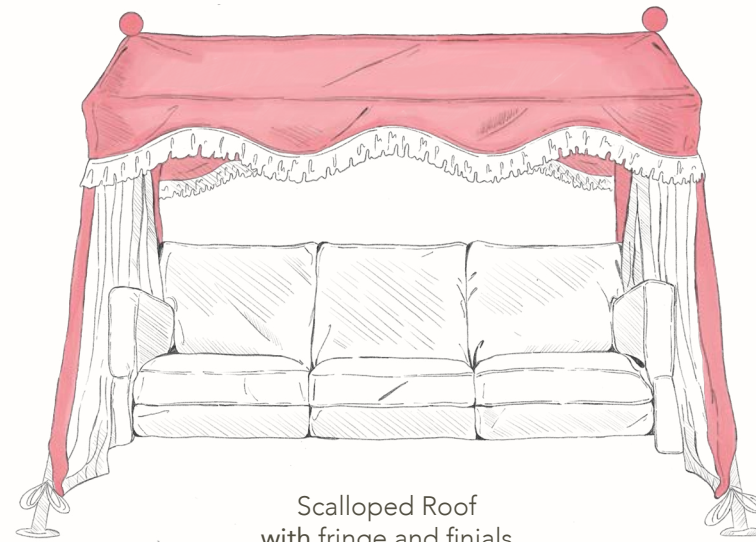

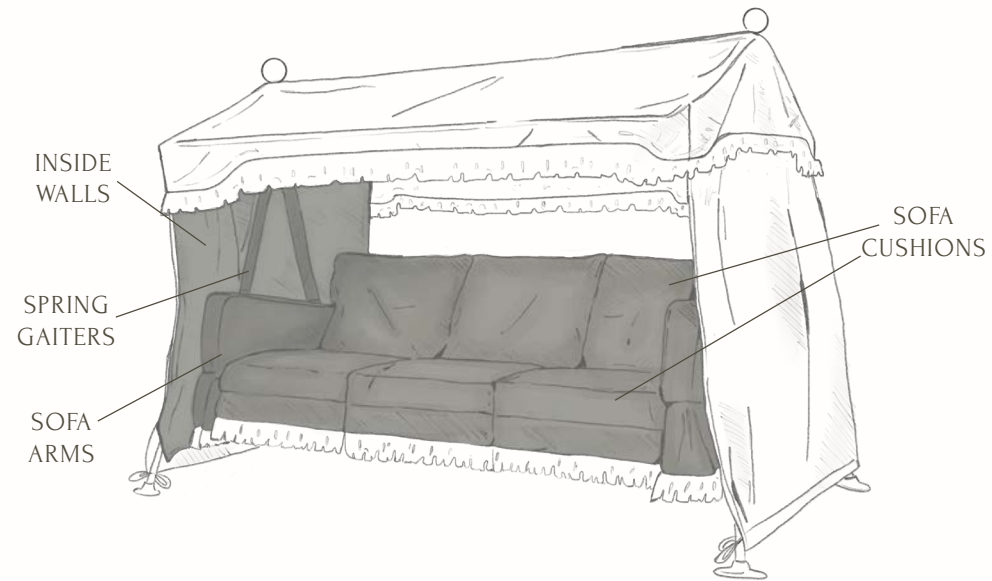

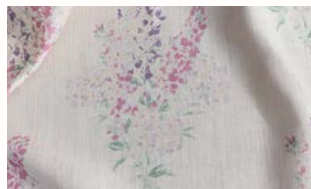

ODD'S ROCKERS

Care and Repair

ODD's rockers can be left outside throughout the spring and summer months. They are supplied with a protective cover, which should be worn every night and in case of any rain. This cover and the exterior of the rocker are made from our marine canvas, which is designed to withstand rain showers and is rot resistant.

We offer repairs or replacements of all upholstered parts of your rocker, in case of damage or staining. We can also replace any lost stainless steel components from the structural frame.

Designing a rocker, with so many different elements to consider, is not unlike putting a scheme together for a small room.

ODD' offers trade clients the opportunity to put their own spin on each rocker, with several customisable parts outlined on the following pages.

FABRICS

We welcome the use of customer's own material on our rockers. The roof & sides of the rocker should be in our canvas, or another performance fabric with the right qualities.

The sofa can be upholstered in any upholstery-weight fabric, and most fabrics can be prepared for use on the inside walls and scatter cushions. We have worked with antique textiles, handpainted fabrics and much more besides for clients who want to make something unique.







BESPOKE SERVICE

FRINGES, TRIMS & TASSELS

The detail makes all the difference. A custom fringe on the roof and sofa can bring the whole scheme together or make a statement on its own. The piping on the sofa can be specified, as can trims and edgings on the inside walls.

Tie-backs and tassels have even been hung from the frame on each side.



BESPOKE SERVICE

FINIALS

Our classic ball finials can be painted to your preference, and there are plenty of options available for those who want something different.

We work with a carpenter in Sussex who can turn bespoke shapes, and we can also repurpose finials intended for other purposes, hand-painting in a weather-resistant finish.







ODD'S GARDEN PARASOLS

ODD draws on its specialism in outdoor furniture with a collection of timeless British parasols that are built to last.

The octagonal frame is made by a specialist partner here in England, shaped from hardwood sapele chosen for its stability.

The outer canopy is handmade from ODD's water-resistant canvas, with an option to include a loose inner canopy in an interior fabric for a splash of colour and pattern.

The parasols have a 2.4m diameter, making them suitable for a dining table but not out of place over beds at the poolside.

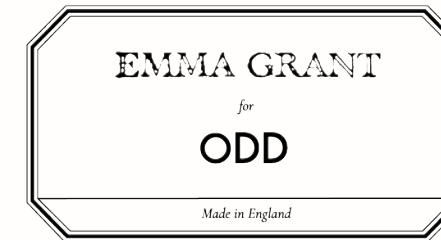

ODD's first designer collaboration with interior decorator Emma Grant features a collection of fabrics (both indoor and outdoor) and several new rocker designs.

The collection brings pattern for the first time to ODD's range of outdoor fabrics, aiming to offer a quality and beauty we felt was hard to come by in performance fabrics.

The fabrics were developed with the new rocker designs in mind, both drawing on historical references and Emma's own collection of antiques.



VAAS

The Vaas motif was inspired by a Dutch 18th century tin glazed ceramic Emma acquired years ago.

The 'Delft' colour-way mimics the royal cobalt blue pigment that was widely used in 18th century Delftware.

The monochrome 'Manganese' colour-way is inspired by magnesium dioxide pigment that can achieve black brown and purple in ceramics and was popularly used in late 17th and 18th century Delft pottery.

BARACCA

Baracca's inspiration is drawn from two sources: an 18th century Portuguese metal threaded tent lining and a Spanish Manises ceramic.

These were developed respectively as a block print and watercolour then unified in Baracca's lively pattern repeat.

The fabric is available in two blues: Indigo & Mid-Indigo, inspired by the natural dye, as well as the sepia-toned Fawn.

ATLAS STRIPE

Atlas Stripe takes its inspiration from a berber textile in Emma's collection.

The broad stripes, reminiscent of Edwardian beach tents, are bordered by a North African motif which was developed as a block print to run along the stripes.

Atlas Stripe is available in Madder Red & Indigo and the softer tonal Ochre colourway, all recalling historical hues achieved using natural dyes.

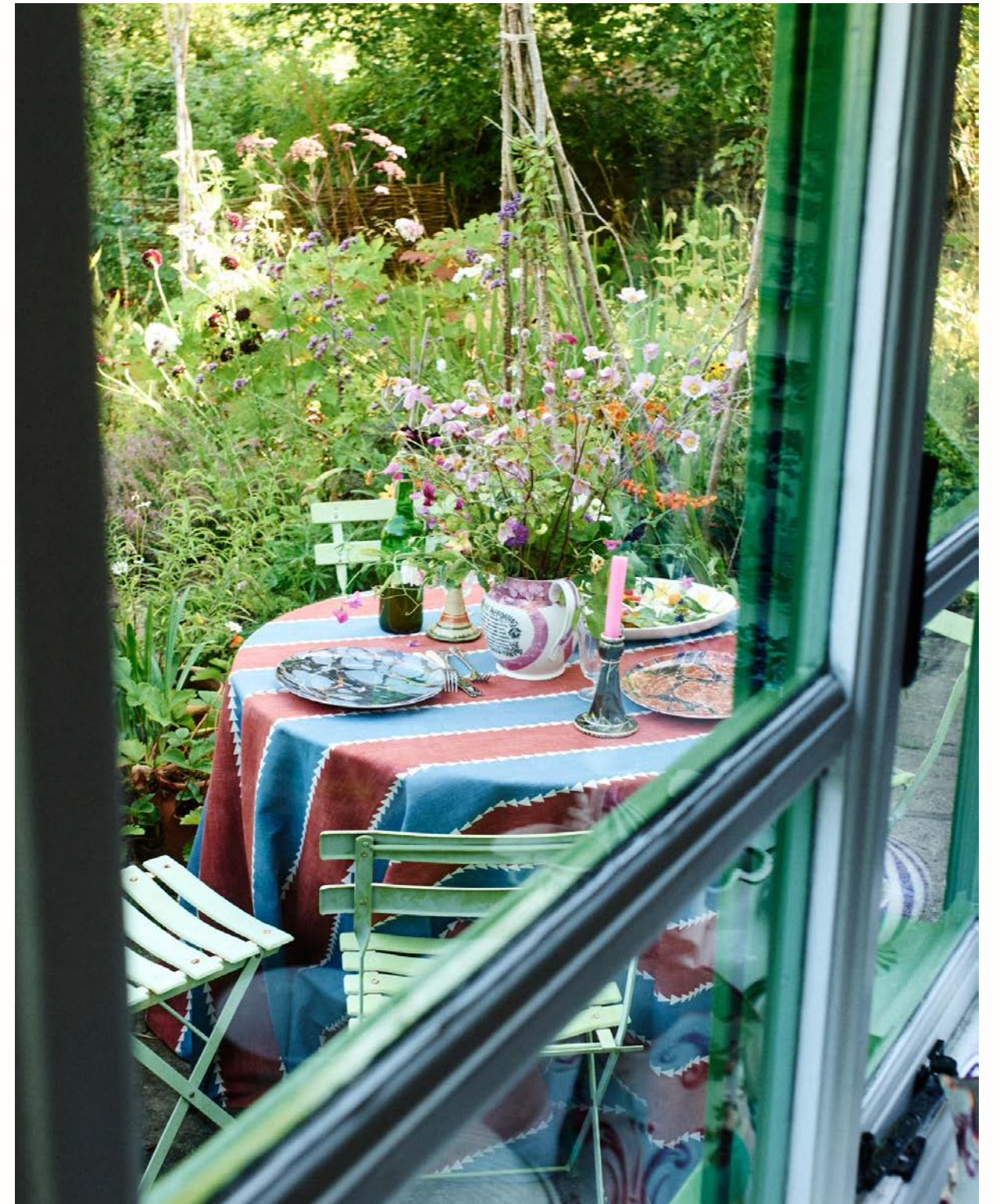


Atlas Stripe Madder & Indigo

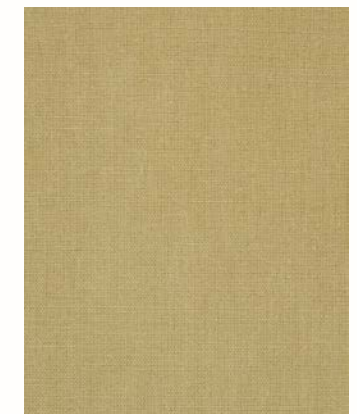

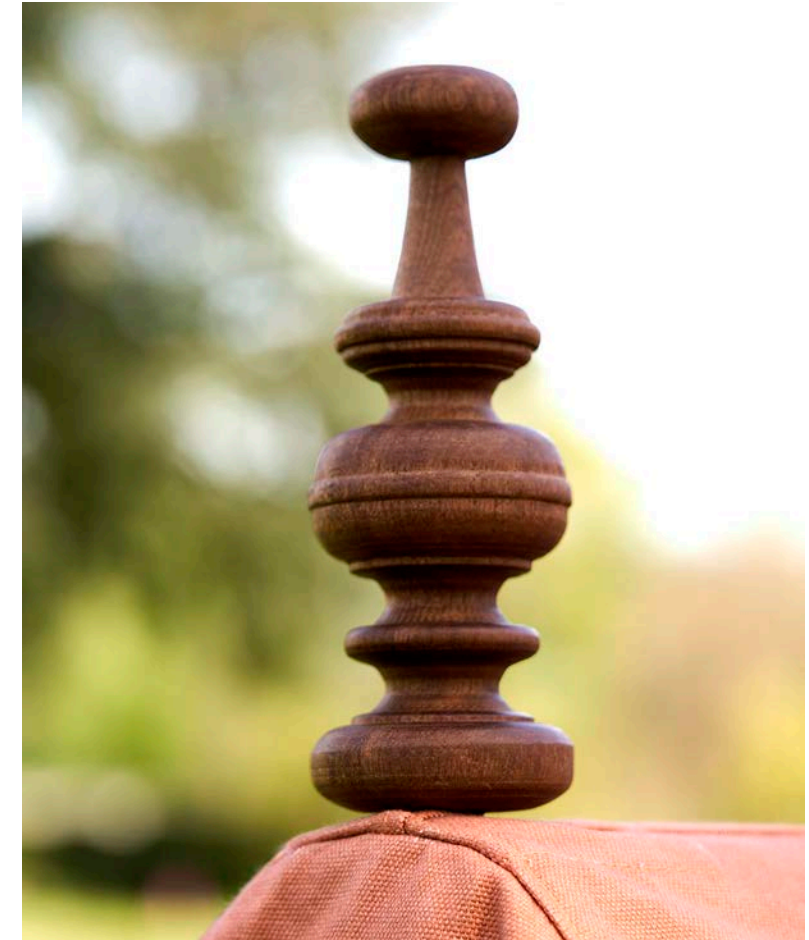
